List of what you need:


- 1) 13 Pegs cut to 20cm long – you can use plastic conduit or hard wood or steel or even small plastic bottles filled with sand for pegs
- 2) Two measuring ropes - One 1m long and the other 2m long with loops tied into each end
- 3) Measuring stick 37.5cm long
- 4) Planting stick rounded on the one end
- 5) Matchbox
- 6) A large book or piece of newspaper
- 7) 500ml of Woodash
- 8) 1 Checkers packet or 6 litres of fresh Manure
- 9) 5 Checkers packets of dry grass or leaves
- 10) 25 Green Bean seeds, 10 Spinach seedlings, 10 Beetroot seedlings and 10 Spring onion seedlings

## Fracturing



## Digging Furrows



## Inputs per Row



Spread inputs evenly across each furrow


## Cover Level and Water in Well




Push 3cm deep holes  
10cm apart

Plant 10 seeds per row and cover level

## Mulching Beans



Mulch with grass/leaves 2.5cm thick but  
leave a 5cm gap for bean seed germination

## Planting Seedlings


Spinach - 20cm

Beetroot/Spring Onion - 10cm

Push holes 6cm deep; place seedling;  
press from the side to close air spaces

## Mulching Seedlings

Mulch between seedlings 2.5cm thick
